Sumo (, sum) is a Japanese style of wrestling and Japan's national sport.

It originated in ancient times as a performance 3 to entertain the Shinto deities.

Many rituals with religious background, such as the symbolic purification of the ring with salt, are 3 still followed today.

In line with tradition, only men practice the sport professionally in Japan.

The rules are simple: the wrestler who 3 first exits the ring or touches the ground with any part of his body besides the soles of his feet 3 loses.

Matches take place on an elevated ring (dohyo), which is made of clay and covered in a layer of sand.

A 3 contest usually lasts only a few seconds, but in rare cases can take a minute or more.

There are no weight 3 restrictions or classes in sumo, meaning that wrestlers can easily find themselves matched off against someone many times their size.

As 3 a result, weight gain is an essential part of sumo training.

Tournaments and Ranking Hierarchy

The governing body of professional sumo is 3 the Japan Sumo Association.

Six tournaments are held every year: three in Tokyo (January, May and September) and one each in 3 Osaka (March), Nagoya (July) and Fukuoka (November).

Each tournament lasts 15 days during which wrestlers compete in one bout per day 3 except lower ranked wrestlers who compete in fewer bouts.

All sumo wrestlers are classified in a ranking hierarchy (banzuke), which is 3 updated after each tournament based on the wrestlers' performance.

Wrestlers with positive records (more wins than losses) move up the hierarchy, 3 while those with negative records get demoted.

The top division is called Makuuchi and the second division Juryo.

At the pinnacle of 3 the sumo hierarchy stands the yokozuna (grand champion).

Unlike wrestlers in lower ranks, a yokozuna cannot be demoted, but he will 3 be expected to retire

when his performance begins to worsen.

How to see a sumo tournament

The best way to see sumo is to attend a sumo tournament.

Tickets are sold for each day of the 15-day tournaments.

They can be purchased in advance through the official vendor or via buysumotickets.com.

Alternatively, they can be purchased at convenience stores (some Japanese skills required) or at the stadiums.

Three types of seats are available to regular visitors: Ringside seats:

Located closest to the ring, ringside seats are most expensive and most difficult to get.

Ticket holders sit on cushions on the floor and are exposed to the risk of injury due to wrestlers flying into the spectators.

Balcony seats:
On the second floor balcony, there are several rows of Western-style seats.

Balcony seats, too, are further classified into A, B and C seats depending on distance to the ring.

Furthermore, there is one section for exclusive use by holders of same-day tickets, the cheapest ticket type, which can be purchased only on the day at the stadium.

The stadium often sells out, especially on weekends and national holidays.

But even if a day is sold out in advance, a limited number of same-day balcony seat tickets are sold on the day at the stadium.

Sumo tickets go on sale roughly one month before the start of each tournament.

A tournament day

Lower division matches start from 8:30 (from 10:00 on days 13-15), second division (Juryo)

matches from 15:00 and top division (Makuuchi) matches from 16:00.

Ring entering ceremonies between divisions are also interesting to watch.

The highest ranked wrestlers have their matches just before 18:00.

On the last day of each tournament, the schedule is shifted forward by 30 minutes to accommodate the victory ceremony at the end.

The stadium atmosphere improves with the arrival of more spectators as it gets later in the day when the most spectacular matches happen.

Intervals between bouts also lengthen as they include longer preparation times and more pre-match action between the high-ranked wrestlers.

We recommend spectators with limited time to be present at the stadium at least for the top division action between 15:30 and 18:00.

Other sumo events

For those visiting Japan between sumo tournaments, there are a few other ways to see sumo matches.

They include exhibition tournaments that are held across the country in between official tournaments and occasional retirement ceremonies of prominent wrestlers.

Retirement ceremonies usually include an exhibition contest, some light-hearted performances by wrestlers and a time-consuming hair cutting ritual to sever the top knot that is symbolic to an active wrestler.

Outside the professional sumo world, there are some universities and high schools that maintain sumo clubs, some of which may be able to accommodate visits by tourists.

Furthermore, there are occasional sumo contests at some shrines and festivals.

Visiting a sumo stable

Perhaps the best way to appreciate sumo besides attending a tournament is to visit a sumo stable to witness a morning practice session.

Sumo stables are where the wrestlers live and train together and where all aspects of life, from sleeping and eating to training and free time, are strictly regimented by the stable master.

There are about forty stables, all of which are located in the Greater Tokyo Region, especially in Tokyo's Ryogoku district.

However, sumo stables are neither public places nor sightseeing spots.

Only a small number of stables accept visits by tourists, and they insist that tourists are accompanied by a person who is fluent in Japanese and closely familiar with the customs of the sumo world.

Furthermore, visitors are expected to follow the house rules strictly and not disturb the training session.

Expect to sit silently on the floor for two to three hours.

In practice, it is very difficult for foreign tourists to visit a stable on their own.

Instead, the recommended way to witness a morning practice is to join a guided tour.

Various organizations and companies, such as Klook and Rakuten, offer such tours and typically charge around 10,000 yen for a single person and around 4000 yen for additional group members.

Other sumo-related attractions

Tokyo's Ryogoku district has been the center of the sumo world for about two centuries.

The district is home to many sumo stables and the Kokugikan sumo stadium where three of the six annual tournaments are held.

Below are a few more of Ryogoku's attractions that could be of interest to sumo fans:

Nigel Farage não concorrerá às eleições gerais do Reino Unido

Nigel Farage anunciou que não concorrerá às eleições gerais do Reino Unido, dealbando um golpe à bwin ios própria formação política, o Reform UK, no primeiro dia de bwin ios campanha eleitoral.

Farage fez o anúncio na sexta-feira, antes do líder do Reform UK, Richard Tice, lançar a campanha eleitoral geral do partido bwin ios uma conferência de imprensa bwin ios Londres.

Farage disse bwin ios um tweet: "Pensei muito e cuidadosamente se devia concorrer às eleições gerais iminentes. Como presidente honorário do Reform UK, estou plenamente apoiante do líder Richard Tice e insto os eleitores a confiarem nele e bwin ios Lee Anderson [o único deputado do partido]. Farei a minha parte para ajudar na campanha, mas não é o momento certo para eu ir além disso."

Adicionou que queria ser livre para fazer campanha nas eleições presidenciais dos EUA mais tarde este ano. "Importante quanto a eleição geral possa ser, a disputa nos Estados Unidos da América bwin ios 5 de novembro tem uma enorme significância global."

Popularidade de Farage

Farage é o político mais popular do Reino Unido, de acordo com a YouGov, e muitos no Reform acreditavam que ele turbochargeria bwin ios campanha e siphonaria mais votos dos Conservadores ao concorrer por um assento.

Uma pesquisa da Savanta na sexta-feira mostrou que ele é especialmente popular entre os eleitores conservadores, com cerca de um terço deles dizendo que estavam desapontados porque ele não estava concorrendo. Uma pesquisa da YouGov, no entanto, mostrou que o Reform dobrou bwin ios participação entre os britânicos de classe trabalhadora, de 7 pontos bwin ios 2024 para 14 pontos agora.

Reações a decisão de Farage

Um ativista do Reform disse: "Ele basicamente manteve as pessoas à espera por anos e agora parece que está apenas tapando buracos para o futuro."

Um dos candidatos do partido disse: "Quem sabe qual é a verdadeira motivação dele? Todo o que sei é que, se o Reform UK quiser se tornar uma força política de longo prazo no Reino Unido, não podemos ser dependentes do carisma de um homem."

Tice minimizou qualquer sugestão de que possa estar desapontado com a decisão de Farage, dizendo aos repórteres bwin ios seu lançamento de campanha: "Nigel nunca disse que iria concorrer. Estou encantado de que ele esteja capaz de nos ajudar a campanha nas próximas seis semanas. É a primeira vez que ele consegue fazer isso, estou entusiasmado com isso."

Tice também confirmou que Farage ficará de lado durante a campanha para apresentar seu programa no GB News.
