Information We Collect

1 Information You Provide Us.

You can provide information to us through various means using our Digital Properties.

We collect both personal information, which is information that identifies you as an individual or relates to an identifiable individual, and non-personal information.

The information we collect may include the following:

During the My24 online account creation process, you will select a user name and password.

If you purchase any products or services through our Digital Properties, we or our payment processors collect your credit card or debit card number and related information, as applicable.

We collect information from you when you purchase a membership and other services from us,

including when you use the 24GO mobile app to purchase 1 a membership and/or access other services.

If you sign up for a free day pass to our clubs, you will provide 1 us with certain information, such as your name, email address, telephone number, and birthdate.

If you use certain of our mobile 1 applications, we will collect information about any fitness devices that you choose to connect to the application, such as sensors 1 and wearable devices, as well as the activity and other information collected through any such fitness devices.

In addition, if you 1 choose to add a third-party fitness data platform to the 24GO mobile application (such as Apple Health, Google Fit, or 1 Fitbit), we will collect information from any such platform.

Such information may include, for example, body measurements and activity types and 1 data (e.g.

, steps, heart rate, distance, speed, sleep).

You may revoke your consent to such sharing by accessing the settings for 1 the relevant platform.

If you choose to connect your social media account to your Digital Properties account, certain personal information from 1 your social media account will be shared with us, which may include personal information that is part of your profile 1 or your friends' profiles.

You may revoke your consent to have the social media platform share information with us by changing 1 your settings within such platform.2.

2 Log Information We Collect from You Automatically.

We collect certain information automatically as you use our 1 Digital Properties, including your IP (Internet Protocol) address, browser type, computer type, type of mobile device (if used), the carrier 1 for your mobile device, your computer operating system, the version of the Digital Properties that you access, the site from 1 where you navigated to our Digital Properties, the time and date of using the Digital Properties, whether you are a 1 repeat visitor, how long you use the Digital Properties and the pages that you view.

We may derive your approximate location 1 from your IP address.2.3 App Usage Data.

When you download and use any of our mobile applications, we and our service 1 providers may track and collect app usage data, such as the date and time the app on your device accesses 1 our servers.2.4 Cookies.

When you visit or use our Digital Properties, we send one or more "cookies" to your computer or 1 other device.

A cookie is a small file containing a string of characters that is sent to your computer when you 1 visit a website.

When you visit the website again, the cookie allows that site to recognize your browser.

Cookies may store unique 1 identifiers, user preferences and other information.

You may opt-out of most cookies through available links on our site and as described 1 in Section 4.2.

You can also reset your browser to refuse or restrict most cookies or to indicate when a cookie 1 is being sent.

However, some website features or services may not function properly without cookies.

Cookie based opt-outs must be performed on 1 each device and browser that you wish to have opted-out.

You must separately opt out in each browser on each device.

We 1 use cookies to improve the quality of our service, including for storing user preferences, tracking user trends and providing relevant 1 advertising to you based on your activities on the Digital Properties and on other websites.

At this time, we do not 1 respond to browser 'do not track' signals.2.5 Pixel Tags.

We may use "pixel tags," which are small graphic files that allow 1 us to monitor the use of our websites.

A pixel tag can collect information such as the IP address of the 1 computer that downloaded the page on which the tag appears; the URL of the page on which the pixel tag 1 appears; the time the

page containing the pixel tag was viewed; the type of browser that fetched the pixel tag; 1 and the identification number of any cookie on the computer previously placed by that server.

When corresponding with you via HTML 1 capable email, we may use "format sensing" technology, which allows pixel tags to let us know whether you received and 1 opened our email. We use Google Analytics, which uses cookies and similar technologies to collect and analyze information about use of 1 the Digital Properties and report on activities and trends.

This service may also collect information regarding the use of other websites, 1 apps and online resources.

6 Physical Location.

We may collect the physical location of your device by, 1 for example, using satellite, cell phone tower, or WiFi signals.

We may use your device's physical location to provide you with 1 location-based services and content and to learn when you have checked into one of our clubs.

We may also share your 1 device's physical location, combined with information about what advertisements you viewed and other information we collect, with our marketing service 1 providers to enable them to provide you with more localized content and to study the effectiveness of advertising campaigns.

You may 1 be able to allow or deny such uses and/or sharing of your device's location by changing your device's location settings, 1 but if you choose to deny such uses and/or sharing, we and our marketing service providers may not be able 1 to provide you with the location-based services and content.2.7 Other Sources.

We may receive information about you from other sources, such 1 as public databases, commercially available sources, service providers, advisors and agents, advertising networks, data analytics providers, internet service providers, operating 1 systems and platforms, social networks, employers, government entities and other third parties, including via referrals from other members or guests 1 or in connection with purchases of any "Add-On" memberships that include you as a member.2.

8 Aggregated Information.

We may aggregate or 1 deidentify personal information.

Aggregated or deidentified information does not identify and is not associated with you or any other user of 1 our Digital Properties.2.

8 Verification Information.

In connection with the COVID-19 pandemic, and in conjunction with federal, state and local requirements, 24 1 Hour Fitness may screen and collect certain information from members and guests, including verification of vaccinated status or a pre-entry 1 negative test result, where permitted or required, as part of the club check-in process ("Verification Information").

Access to certain 24 Hour 1 Fitness clubs is currently limited to individuals who can provide a verification of vaccinated status or a pre-entry negative test 1 result.

We will check your Verification Information when you check in, but we will not make a copy of the Verification 1 Information, itself.

If you prefer not to have 24 Hour Fitness indicate in our systems that you have provided your Verification 1 Information, you will need to bring your Verification Information each time you visit a club.

Any Verification Information indications that we 1 retain will be stored for a reasonable period of time, including as we determine necessary to comply with applicable law 1 or to establish or defend our legal rights.

Please note that options for providing Verification Information vary by jurisdiction based on 1 federal, state and local requirements and may change from time to time.3.

How We Use Your Information3.

1 To Provide Products, Services, 1 and Information.

As described above, we collect information from you so that we can provide products and services that you purchase 1 or otherwise request using the Digital Properties and information that you request from us.

For example, we use your personal information 1 to:

Set-up your membership

Provide services and products to you

Process payments for your membership and services, including credit card, debit card and 1 bank account debit (ACH) transactions

Contact you regarding your membership and services, and other administrative information

Track member and guest use of 1 our facilities

Respond to your inquiries, comments, reviews and ratings³.

2 Marketing Emails We may use your information to send you marketing 1 communications that we believe may be of interest to you.

You can always opt-out of receiving marketing emails by using the 1 opt-out feature provided with the email communications.³

5 Our Business Purposes.

We may use your information for our business purposes, such as 1 data analysis, research, audits, fraud monitoring and prevention, developing new products and services, enhancing, improving or modifying our Digital Properties, 1 identifying usage trends, determining the effectiveness of our promotional campaigns and operating and expanding our business activities.³

3.6 Other Purposes.

We may 1 use non-personal information for any purpose, except where we are required to do otherwise under applicable law.

2 Advertising and 1 Third Party Advertisers.

We may use third-party advertising companies to serve advertisements regarding goods and services that may be of interest 1 to you when you access and use our Clubs, our Digital Properties and other websites and online services, based on 1 information relating to your access to and use of our Digital Properties and other websites and online services on any 1 of your devices, as well as on information received from you both online and offline and from third parties. To do 1 so, these companies may place or recognize a unique cookie on your browser (including through the use of pixel tags), 1 and they may also use the information to measure the effectiveness of ads.

In addition, they may use these technologies, along 1 with information they collect about your online use, to recognize you across the devices you use, such as a mobile 1 phone and a laptop. We may share Digital Properties usage and other information with third party advertisers and partners for the 1 purpose of effectively targeting our online advertisements unless you opt-out. 5 Sharing with Other Services.

You may revoke your consent to such sharing by accessing the settings for the relevant platform. We are required to notify California residents, at or before the point of collection of their personal information, the categories of personal information collected and the purposes for which such information is used.

Verifiable Requests to Delete, and Requests to Know.

Subject to certain exceptions, California residents have the right to make the following requests, at no charge, up to twice every 12 months:

Right of Deletion: California residents have the right to request deletion of their personal information that we have collected about them, subject to certain exemptions, and to have such personal information deleted, except where necessary for any of a list of exempt purposes.

Right to Know – Right to a Copy: California residents have the right to request a copy of the specific pieces of personal information that we have collected about them in the prior 12 months and to have this delivered, free of charge, either (a) by mail or (b) electronically in a portable and, to the extent technically feasible, readily useable format that allows the individual to transmit this information to another entity without hindrance.

Right to Know – Right to Information: California residents have the right to request that we provide them certain information about how we have handled their personal information in the prior 12 months, including the:

categories of personal information collected;

categories of sources of personal information;

business and/or commercial purposes for collecting and selling their personal information;

categories of third parties/with whom we have disclosed or shared their personal information;

categories of personal information that we have disclosed or shared with a third party for a business purpose;

categories of personal information collected; and

categories of third parties to whom the residents' personal information has been sold and the specific categories of personal information sold to each category of third party.

Submitting Requests.

For those with a My24 account, log into your account on the 24 Hour Fitness website, go to the Personal Information page and click on the "California Privacy Rights" and follow instructions.

Requests to exercise these rights may be submitted by clicking Do Not Sell My Personal Information, contacting us at via email at ccpadr24hourfit.com or via (800) 432-6348 (toll free).

We will respond to verifiable requests received from California consumers or authorized agents as required by law.

When you submit a request to know or a request to delete, we will take steps to verify your request by matching the information provided by you with the information we have in our records.

In some cases, we may request additional information in order to verify your request or where necessary to process your request.

If we are unable to adequately verify a request, we will notify the requester.

Authorized agents may initiate a request on behalf of a California individual (and we may confirm this request with the individual), and authorized agents will be required to provide proof of their authorization as permitted by applicable law.

Right to Non-Discrimination, and Incentives.

The CCPA prohibits discrimination against California residents for exercising their rights under the CCPA and imposes requirements on any financial incentives offered to California residents related to their personal information.

We do not currently offer any financial incentive programs.

Categories of Personal Information.

The table 1 below identifies the categories of personal information (as defined by the CCPA) we have collected about consumers in the past 12 months.

Customer Records 1 Includes personal information, such as name, account name, user ID, contact information, employer, account number, and financial or payment information, 1 that individuals provide us in order to purchase or obtain our products and services.

Geolocation Data Includes location information about a particular individual or device.

Audio, Video and Electronic Data Includes audio, electronic, visual, thermal, olfactory, or similar information such as, CCTV footage (e.g.

, collected 1 from visitors to our facilities), photographs and images (e.g.

, that you provide us or post to your profile) and call 1 recordings (e.g.

, of customer support calls).

Professional information Includes professional and employment-related information (such as current and former employer(s) and position(s), 1 business contact information).

For example, if your employer sponsors your membership plan.

Biometric information Physiological, biological or behavioral characteristics that can be 1 used alone or in combination with each other to establish individual identity.

For example, if you chose to do so, we 1 may use fingerprint scanners for fraud detection and authentication purposes when you enter our facilities.

Inferences Includes inferences drawn from other personal information that we collect to create a profile reflecting an 1 individual's preferences, characteristics, predispositions, behavior, abilities or aptitudes.

For example, we may analyze personal information in order to identify the offers 1 and information that may be most relevant to customers, so that we can better reach them with relevant offers and 1 ads.

Sources of Personal Information.

We may collect information from the sources described in the Information We Collect section above.

Purposes and Categories.

For 1 more information about the business and commercial purposes for which we collect, use, disclose and/or sell personal information and the 1 third parties with whom we may disclose or sell your personal information, please see the How We Use Your Information 1 and How We Share Your Information sections above.

onabet lotion for hair :betano bonus amigo

No mês passado, a Rússia vetou uma resolução da ONU onabet lotion for hair um movimento que efetivamente aboliria o monitoramento por especialistas das Nações Unidas de sanções do Conselho contra Coreia.

Moscou estava agindo para proteger suas compras de armas da Coreia do Norte, a fim que alimentasse onabet lotion for hair guerra na Ucrânia.

"Estou ansioso para me envolver tanto com a República da Coreia e o Japão, mas também estou pensando onabet lotion for hair tentar desenvolver opções dentro das Nações Unidas como fora delas. O ponto aqui é que não podemos permitir um fim no trabalho feito pelo painel de especialistas", disse Linda Thomas-Greenfield à imprensa durante uma coletiva na capital sul coreana usando seu nome formal?

Thomas-Greenfield não forneceu detalhes específicos sobre as discussões dos EUA com aliados e outros parceiros, incluindo se um regime de monitoramento alternativo seria mais provável ser estabelecido através da Assembleia Geral das Nações Unidas ou onabet lotion for hair uma entidade independente fora do ONU.

Thomas-Greenfield se reuniu com o ministro das Relações Exteriores da Coreia do Sul, Cho Tae yul na segunda e discutiram "próximos passos não especificados para garantir uma continuação de relatórios independentes" sobre as atividades ilícitas norte coreana.

Thomas-Greenfield disse que ficou claro, porém a Rússia e China -que se abstiveram de votar na resolução da ONU vetada por Moscou continuarão tentando bloquear os esforços internacionais para manter o monitoramento das sanções contra Pyongyang. Ela criticou as autoridades russas

pela violação dessas mesmas medidas com suas supostas compras onabet lotion for hair armas à Coreia do Norte; além disso também criticava Pequim pelo fato dos EUA protegerem norte não serem responsabilizados pelas acusações feitas pelos Estados Unidos sobre seu país vizinho ao Irã (ver).

Moscou e Pequim têm frustrado os esforços liderados pelos EUA para apertar as sanções da ONU contra a Coreia do Norte por causa de seus testes com mísseis balísticos desde 2024, ressaltando uma divisão entre membros permanentes que se aprofundaram na guerra russa à Ucrânia.

"Não espero que eles cooperem ou concordem com qualquer esforço para encontrar outro caminho, mas isso não vai nos impedir de descobrir esse rumo", disse Thomas-Greenfield.

Quando questionada sobre o pedido da Autoridade Palestina para ter adesão plena à ONU, ela disse que uma resolução das Nações Unidas onabet lotion for hair apoio a esse requerimento não contribuiria com encontrar solução de dois Estados ao conflito israelo-palestino.

"O presidente Biden disse categoricamente que apoiamos uma solução de dois Estados para lidar com a situação no Oriente Médio, onde os palestinos terão um estado próprio e Israel está seguro onabet lotion for hair seu Estado", afirmou.

"Não vemos que fazer uma resolução no Conselho de Segurança necessariamente nos levará a um lugar onde podemos encontrar... solução para dois Estados", acrescentou.

O painel de especialistas disse que está investigando 58 supostos ataques cibernético da Coreia do Norte entre 2024 e 2024 avaliados onabet lotion for hair aproximadamente BR R\$ 3 bilhões, com o dinheiro supostamente sendo usado para ajudar a financiar seu desenvolvimento.
